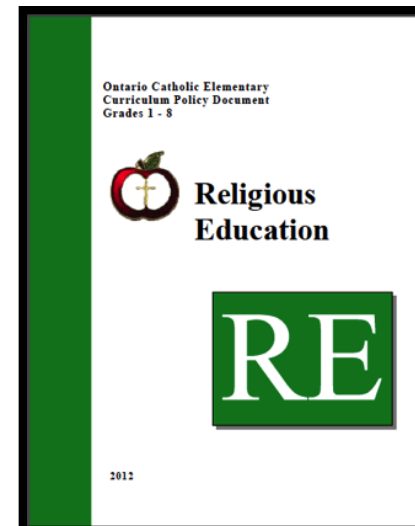

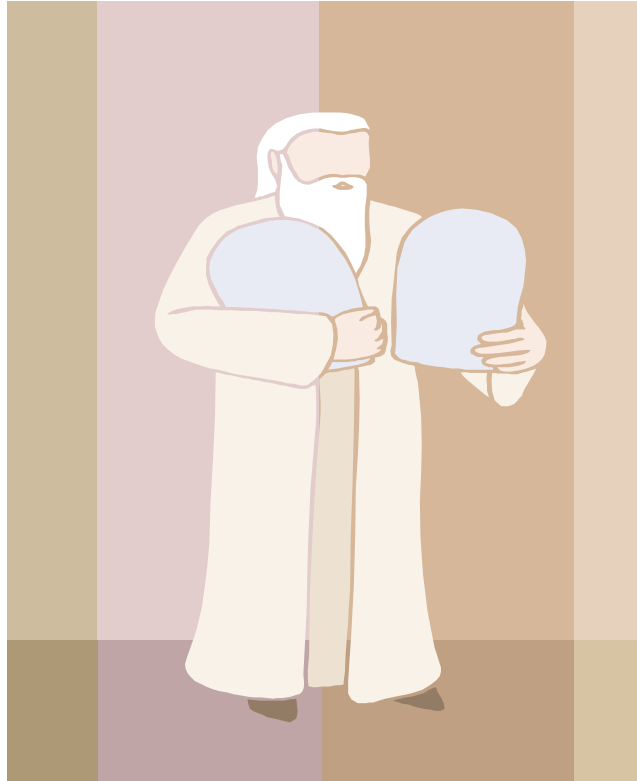
Why create the Elementary Religious Education (RE) Policy document at this time?

- ❧ Ardent and courageous proclamation of the Gospel of Jesus Christ
- ❧ Authentic teaching of the doctrine of the Church
- ❧ Adapted to the needs of the times
- ❧ Promotes enculturation of the faith
- ❧ Responsibility of all Baptized
- ❧ Promotes laws and institutions in harmony with Christ's teachings
- ❧ Evangelizes not only individual, but cultures and societies
- ❧ Focus on Ecumenical and Inter-religious dialogue

The 8 Elements of the New Evangelization

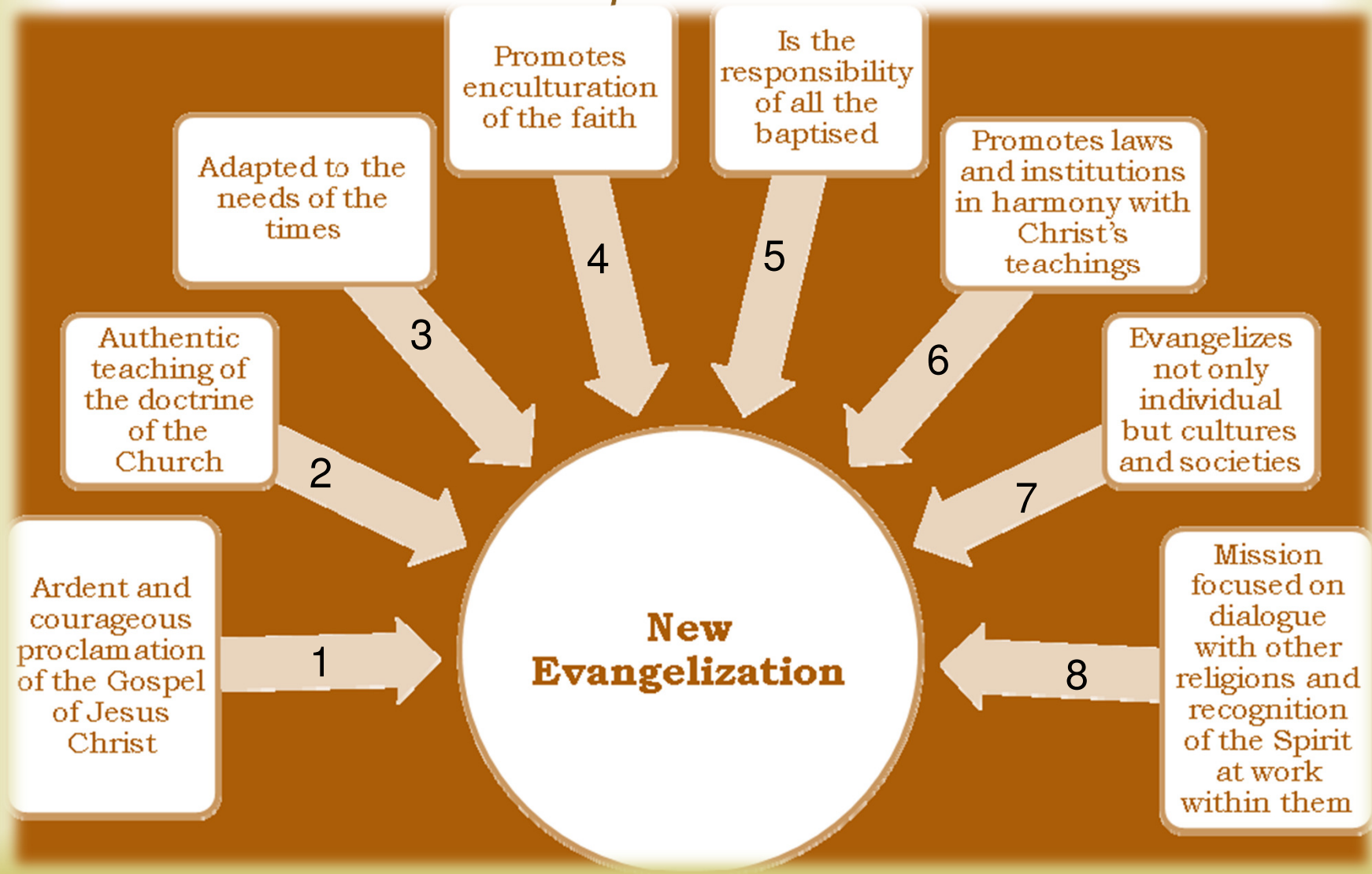


OPTION B: **THINK / PAIR / SHARE**
